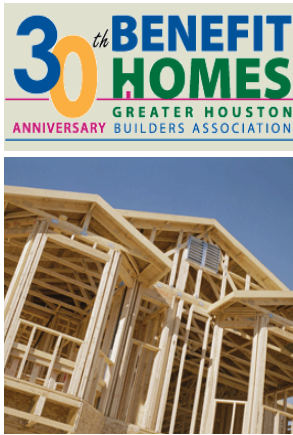


# SUPPORT YOUR COMMUNITY GHBA BENEFIT HOMES

## What is the GHBA Benefit Homes Project?

It was thirty years ago when the Greater Houston Builders Association envisioned a charitable project that would bring the generosity of GHBA member vendors, builders and developers together to give back to Houston.

After careful and thoughtful planning, the GHBA formed the Benefit Homes Project and the mission became: To ensure a brighter future for the community's less fortunate, through the heart and hands of the homebuilding industry. The goal was to do what the GHBA members do best, to build quality homes that are sold at market value for a profit. The majority of that profit would be donated to charity.

Over the life of this program the GHBA has donated close to \$6 million dollars to local charities. Currently the Benefit Homes Project distributes the majority of the proceeds to the Alzheimer's Association, Texas Children's Cancer Center and HomeAid Houston.

Even the fact Houston experienced its toughest year in recent history in 2009, the builders, developers and vendors came onboard committed to helping those less fortunate.
