PARTNER designation

To qualify as a Greater Houston Builders
Association (GHBA) Professional Builder Partner
(PBP) the associate candidate must demonstrate
certain attributes by being a GHBA Associate
Member in good standing, participate in required
educational classroom hours, and follow the GHBA
Code of Ethics. The PBP designation demonstrates
a level of professionalism that is unique to those
individuals that support the gulf coast area home
building industries. As a PBP the associate shall
support their industry through their participation
and by attending continuing education events.

GHBA Professional Builder Partner (PBP) Initial Requirements:

- Be a GHBA member, or employed by a GHBA member company, in good standing
- Attend 12 ABCs of Homebuilding classes, with a passing exam score of 80%
- Attend a GHBA-sponsored Ethics course
- OSHA 10 Hour Card required
- Upon completion of all requirements pay a Graduation Application fee of \$65

Designation Renewal

(Every 12 months after initial designation)

- Be a GHBA member, or employed by a GHBA member company, in good standing
- Attend 3 ABC's of Homebuilding classes, with a passing exam score of 80% in 12-month period
- Pay annual renewal fee of \$45
